<b>Scene One</b>	
Interviewer	To give us some information about Rag week we introduce Alex Ellery, Student Union President at Southampton Solent University. For those people who don't know could you give us a little bit of background to Rag week, its history and purpose?
Alex	Rag stands for Raise and Give and traditionally students get together and raise money for a charity they want to support that year. Because it is a university the tradition is that it usually involves doing silly things.
